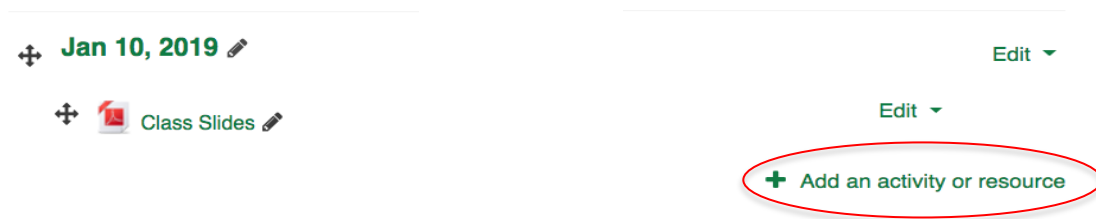


Adding Your Reading List to eClass

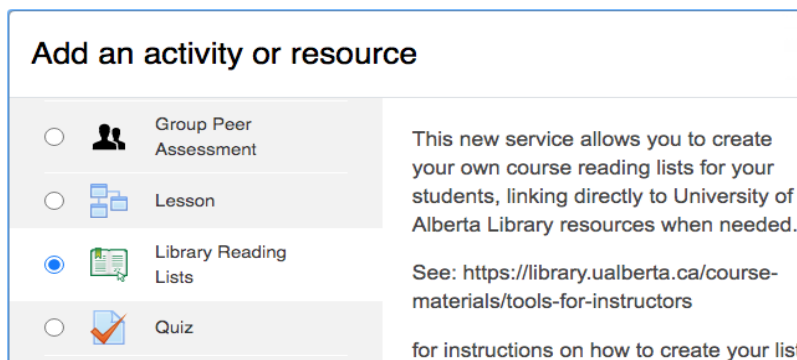
Before you begin: Create your online reading list with the Library's [Course Materials & Reading List Service](#). NOTE: It is currently recommended that you use the Chrome (preferred) or Firefox browser.

Step 1. Sign into your eClass course and turn editing on. Navigate to the section where you want to add the list.

Step 2. Select "Add Activity or resource"



Step 3. Select "Library Reading Lists"



Step 4. On the next screen, under "Activity Name", name your reading list in a way that fits that context of your course. Then click on "Save and display".
